Things to do: Before you can enter a construction site you will need.

- **1)** A White card (WHS)
- 2) Asbestos awareness certificate
- **3)** Silica awareness certificate
- **4)** A colour blind test is required for electricians
- **5)** A Working with Vulnerable People card (WWVP) is required for work environments such as childcare, aged care, nursing, education etc.

Courses are run periodically at Daramalan College. See the Careers Advisor or listen to the daily news for when the next session might be.

Hospitality Industry: Having completed a Barista course (Coffee making) and a Responsible Service of Alcohol course (RSA) is a bonus.

Resume: It is important to have a resume that includes all the relevant skills you have acquired through school or work experience. You can upload this to 'ASBA/Apprenticeship/job seekers' websites.

Part-time/casual work: This is important to understand the workforce and to acquire transferable skills such as communication, teamwork, problem solving, time management, wearing uniform or personal protective equipment (PPE).

Work experience in the area you think you would like to work is important. It will ensure you really like the trade you have chosen as well as give you an insight into this particular work environment, further skills you may require and the opportunity to network with people who may have a job to offer.

School work: Achieving to your best ability in school is important. In the workforce we often have to do jobs that we do not like or find difficult. As adults in the work force, we do not have a choice if we want to keep our job.

A Year 12 Senior Secondary Certificate demonstrates that you are capable of studying and completing tasks.
